- Title or topic of the PhD project
- Beginning and presumed end of Ph.D.
- Organizational affiliation (university, department, supervisor)
- Research question(s), theoretical foundation(s), and (planned) empirical methods
- Short statement on the current state of the PhD and the project(s) to be presented at the workshop (max. 500 words)

Please expect a participation fee of ~200€ (twin room) or ~300€ (single room) (incl. hotel and various meals; discount for AOW-Fachgruppenmitglieder applies).
